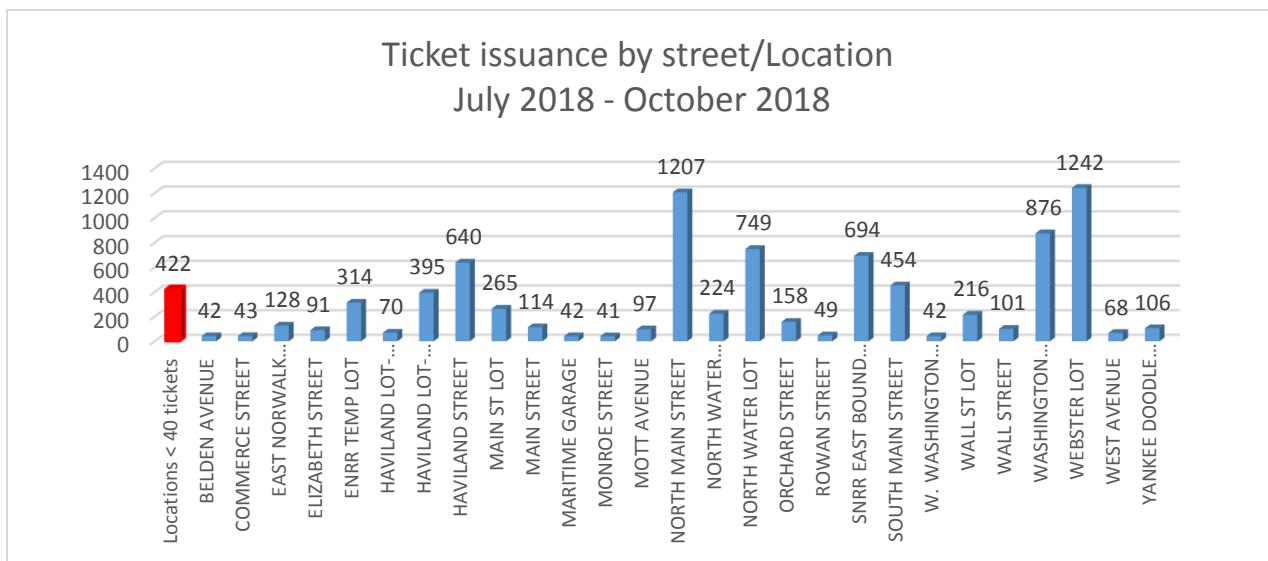


## Ticket Issuance Report July 2018 – October 2018

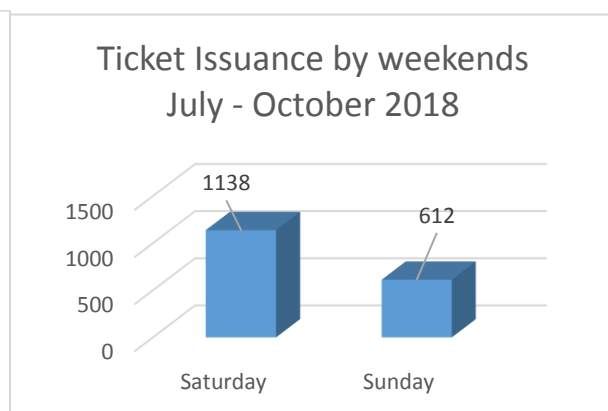
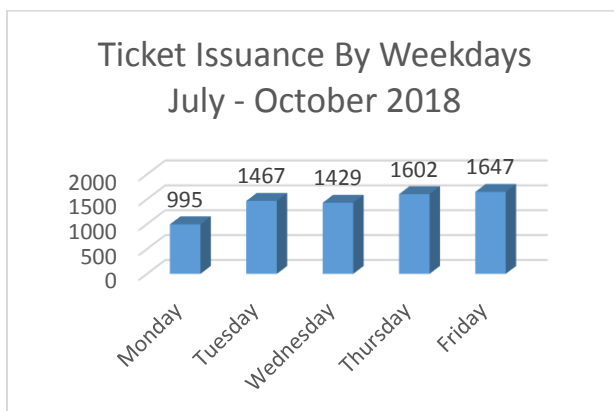
There were a total of 8,890 tickets issued in Norwalk in the past 4 months (July 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 through October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018). Below is the breakdown of the type of violations:

- 60% of the tickets issued was for expired meter and time limit violation.
- 26% of tickets issued was for Courtesy Warning
- 6% of tickets issued was for no parking violation
- 4% of tickets issued was for daily parking at ENRR and SNRR
- The rest of the 4% was for parking without permit, occupying two spaces, parking in a handicap space, daily fee rate at SNRR and ENRR and the likes.

The graph below shows the total tickets issued in Norwalk broken down by Streets/locations. Please note that streets/locations with less than 40 tickets are condensed into one column, and it is highlighted in red in the graph.

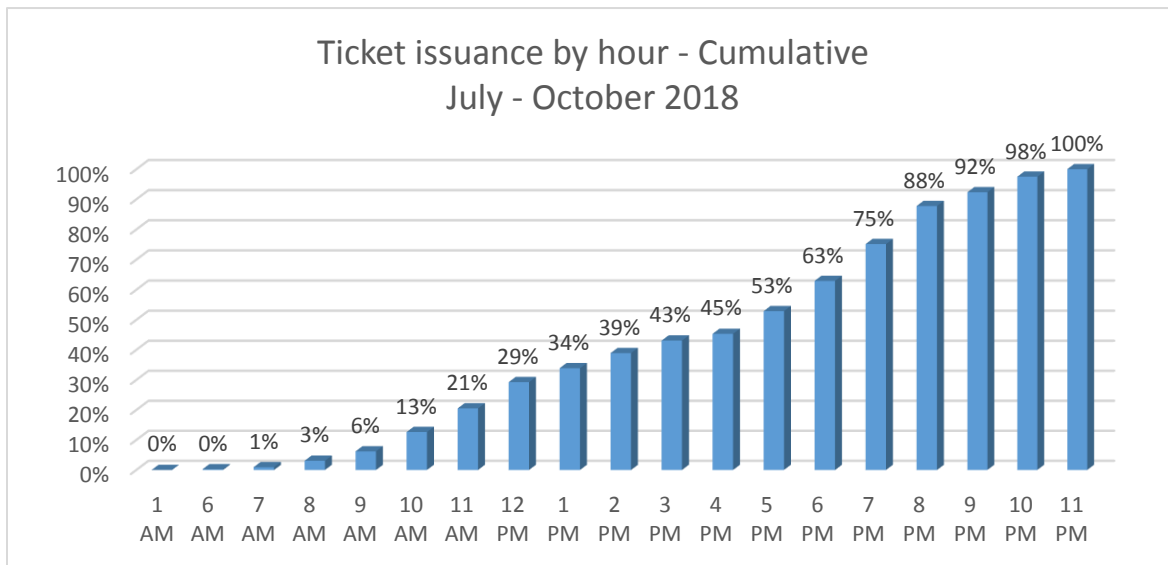
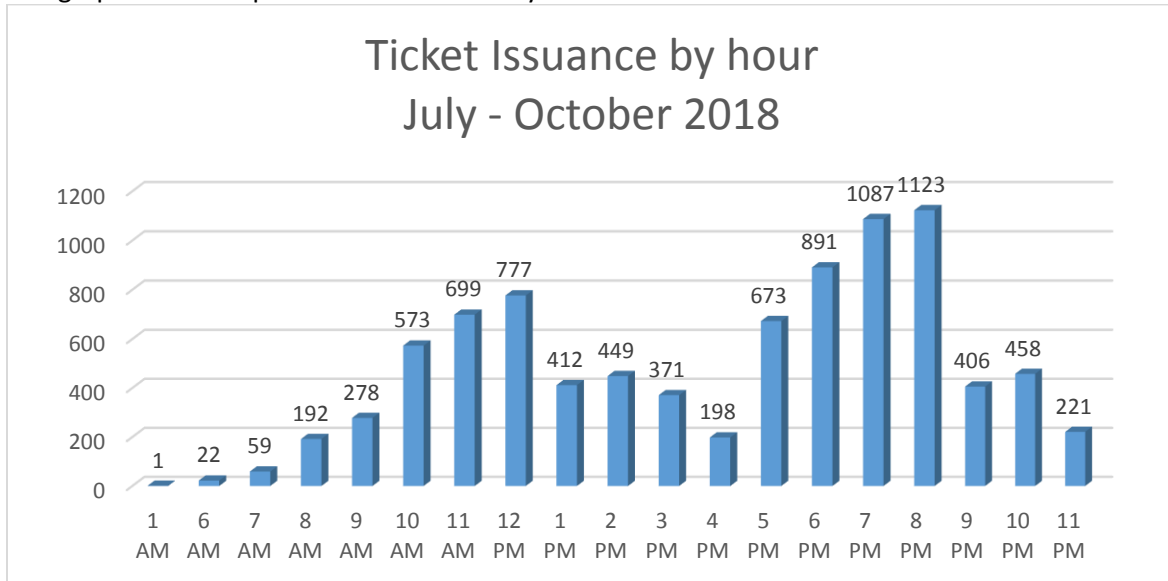


We have further analyzed total tickets issued by hours and days. Of the total tickets issued, 80% of the tickets were issued during weekdays and 20% issued on weekends. Breaking it down further into by hours, 53% of the tickets were issued during the day time (6am - 5pm) while 47% of the tickets were issued during the evening hours (6pm - 12am). The graphs below show ticket issuance by weekdays and weekends.

The graphs below explain ticket issuance by hours.



As we can see from the analysis, the majority of the tickets were issued for Expired Meter and Time Limit Violations. To better understand this, we are going to analyze this further below.

Expired meter and Time Limit violations make up 5,362 (60%) of the total tickets issued in Norwalk. Out of the total of 5,362 Expired meter/time limit violations tickets issued, 78.8% of the tickets were issued in SONO area, 18% were issued in Wall area, 1.7% were issued in SONO/Wall corridor and 1.5% were issued in East Norwalk area.

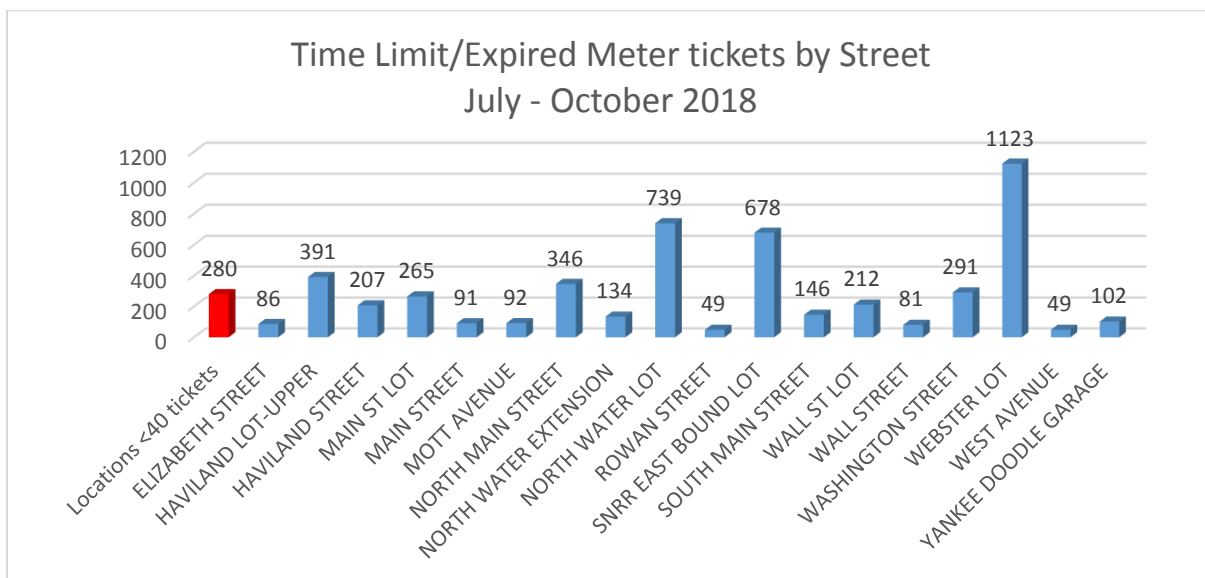

In the time frame analyzed, there were a total of 49 locations that time limit and expired meter violation tickets were issued. These locations include the different on street and off street parking spaces. The top 5 locations represent 61% of the total expired and time limit violations. These locations are:

<b>SNRR East Bound Lot</b>	<b>678</b>
<b>Haviland Lot Upper</b>	<b>391</b>

In the graph below, we try to show the areas where most of the violation tickets are issued. We have consolidated locations with less than 30 tickets for the past 2 months into one category, and it is highlighted in red in the graph.

### **Conclusion:**

Same time frame last year, there were a total of 9,216 ticket issued. Comparing it to our current year number of 8,890, it is higher by 326 tickets. In the current fiscal year, out of the total 8,890 tickets issued, 2,316 of the tickets are warning tickets while 1,963 out of the 9,216 of last year tickets were warning. This brings our total ticket issued for the current year to 6,574 and last year's to 7,253. This is a 9.4% decrease in ticket issuance over last year's number.
