The exhibit entitled, "From A Student's Perspective," features art created by students of Norwalk Community College. The exhibit runs from May 30 through June 29, 2019 with an opening reception on May 30th at 5:00 pm.

"From a Students Perspective" presents a variety of artworks from students who are pursuing a degree in the Studio Arts from the Art, Architecture and Design Department at Norwalk Community College. A selection of works in drawing, painting, design, photography, ceramics and sculpture will be exhibited. NCC offers two-year Associate Degrees in Studio and Fine Arts, Architectural Engineering, Interior Design, Graphic Design and Web Design.
