

Twelve Months Transient Activity
July 2016 – June 2017

Twelve Months Activity High Light:

Train station facilities (SNRR garage and Lot): – showed 13,960 less activity due to Stamford garage reopening.

Maritime Garage: showed 7,523 more transactions.

Webster Lot: showed 9,833 less transactions because of lack of train station overflow parkers and movie theatre underperforming (lack of major hit movies).

Haviland Lot: showed 3,294 more transactions due to increased activity.

North Water Lot: showed 4,203 more transactions due to increased activity in the district. North Water lot has seen the most increase in the SONO area considering the size of the lot.

Yankee Doodle Garage: showed 15,258 more transactions due to increased demand, construction in the area and night and weekend extended hours.

On-Street Parking: showed 90,858 more transactions mainly due to increased hours of operations and newly added meters. Comparing same hours of operation as 2015/16, there were 25,668 more transactions in 2016/17 that are directly attributed to an increased activity in the district.

Overall, SONO core business area (excluding Webster Lot) has seen 40,688 more transactions.
